FEES and CHARGES: All fees are due at the time of application. Residential service is \$200, Commercial or small industrial service is \$400 or \$2 per amp whichever is greater and Industrial service is \$1000 or \$2 per amp whichever is greater. While no other charges are usually required for most new service installations, the Town reserves the right to charge the customer based on a labor and material basis for work requiring abnormal or extended efforts due to size/length, necessary parts/equipment, and or labor. Relocations or service upgrades are charged on a labor and material basis, with a required initial fee equal to the installation fee (above) of the existing or new service class (whichever is greater), and any remaining balance billed to customer. The meter base will be installed at an accessible outside location approved by the Town of Ferdinand. It must be kept free of obstructions or hazard at all times for the purpose of meter reading, inspection, and maintenance. Temporary service, to include a pole and service drop as necessary, is charged at the actual cost of labor and materials, less the value of any material returned to stock. Town of Ferdinand overhead or underground wires, material, and equipment shall be located as mutually agreed prior to the original installation. Any change in location as agreed, or damage caused by the customer after the installation begins, will be at the customer expense. A schedule of connection fees and monthly charges for residential and as well as other services as may be required for commercial, industrial, and demand classification is available from billing office at Town Hall.

NOTICE: The Town of Ferdinand assumes no responsibility or liability for the interruption of electric service at any time, and the Town shall have the right to discontinue service to the property for any of the following reasons:

1. When the safety of the general public is endangered or public convenience and necessity requires;
2. Defective wiring and or equipment on the premises;
3. Maintenance and or construction purposes as required from time to time;
4. Any violation of Town rules and regulations governing this service;
5. Failure to pay charges for commodities and services rendered when same are due, including any installation/ relocation costs.

Regardless of the classification of electric service, all electric wiring and connections on the customer's side of the meter must conform to the current (NEC) National Electric Code before meter will be set or turned on.

In consideration for granting a connection to the electric system of the Town of Ferdinand, I hereby agree to the following:

1. I have read and understand this application including all associated fees and charges, and to abide by the rules and regulations of the Town of Ferdinand Electric Utility, as they may be revised and modified from time to time. **PROPERTY OWNER INITIAL** _____
2. To grant an easement to the Town of Ferdinand, et al for the purpose of installing and or maintaining utility services up to and including the meter(s) and, if applicable, any contiguous utility main lines whether new or existing, from ingress to egress points on property. **PROPERTY OWNER INITIAL** _____
3. The homeowner is responsible for any replacement and or repair of landscaping or crops that is disturbed or damaged for the purpose of installing, relocating, and or modifying the electric service (typically, but not limited to grass/ grass reseeding, and perpetual backfill of trench line).
PROPERTY OWNER INITIAL _____
4. It is acknowledged and agreed that the Town is under no obligation or liability for service interruptions such as may be required because of or caused by unforeseen circumstances or for normal maintenance as is required from time to time. Additionally, the Town is not required to serve any property until such time as adequate electric distribution lines have been installed and electric service is available to the property.
