## ORDINANCE NO. 2024-<u>13</u>

## AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2023-26 REGARDING SALARIES, COMPENSATION AND WAGES FOR ELECTED OFFICIALS, APPOINTEES AND EMPLOYEES OF THE TOWN OF FERDINAND, INDIANA

**WHEREAS**, the Town Council of the Town of Ferdinand ("Council") adopted Ordinance 2023-26 establishing the wages and salaries for employees for all departments of the Town for 2024 (the "2024 Salary Ordinance"); and

**WHEREAS**, the Council desires to amend the 2024 Salary Ordinance to include the wages of and departmental transfer of an employee in the Water/Wastewater Department to the Street Department; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town has invested time and money to train the transferred employee in its apprentice program so that he can obtain a wastewater operator's license and the Town is desirous of allowing the completion of that training and testing to continue despite the transfer because it gives the Town an additional operator license:

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council that the salary ordinance shall be amended to revise the 2024 Salary Ordinance as follows:

Austin Ryan - Street Department Laborer - MVH Fund except as otherwise noted: \$25.45 per hour, 40 hours per week, plus 2 hours minimum at time and half for emergency calls and 2 hour minimum for non-emergency call outs to service parks. Rotation for emergency and non-emergency call outs to commence after the adoption of this ordinance. Despite the transfer to another department, employee is expected to sit for and pass the operator license test (at the wastewater department's expense) and will be given training time (at the wastewater department's expense) to prepare and sit for for said test. This amendment is effective with the pay period commencing September 6, 2024.
