

TOWN OF FERDINAND

SPECIAL MEETING

October 7, 2025

The Ferdinand Town Council met for a Special Meeting at 12:00 PM on Tuesday, October 7, 2025, in the Ferdinand Town Hall. Present were Vice-President, Debbie Johnson presiding over the meeting; Council Member, Ron Weyer; Attorney, Sharon Bohnenkemper, and Clerk-Treasurer, Tamara Miller.

Ben Brinkman, Water/Wastewater Superintendent, requested permission to extend a conditional offer of employment to Nick Werner, pending drug screening. Ron moved to approve. Debbie seconded. Motion carried 2-0.

Ron moved to adopt Ordinance 2025-18, at the meeting it was introduced, an Ordinance Amending Ordinance 2024-22 Regarding Salaries, Compensation and Wages for Elected Officials, Appointees and Employees of the Town of Ferdinand adding Nick Werner; Water/Wastewater Department at \$23.00 per hour; additional \$.50 per hour after ninety (90) days. Potentially eligible for the apprentice program at a later date. Start Date: October 20, 2025, pending pre-employment testing being favorable. This amendment is effective upon passage. Debbie seconded. Motion carried 2-0.

Ron moved to adopt Ordinance 2025-19, at the meeting it was introduced, An Ordinance Designating and Appointing a New ADA Coordinator. The Town Council designates and appoints Ken Sicard as its ADA Coordinator effective October 4, 2025. Debbie seconded. Motion carried 2-0.

Debbie moved to adopt Ordinance 2025-20, at the meeting it was introduced, An Ordinance stating that Kenneth J. Sicard, as President of the Ferdinand Town Council, is hereby authorized to sign the aforementioned documents and Agreement, without the Clerk-Treasurer, Tamara M. Miller, attesting his signature (which we are told is INDOT's current preference), and the President of the Ferdinand Town Council has the authorization, by virtue of this Ordinance, to bind the Town of Ferdinand in that said Agreement. Ron seconded. Motion carried 2-0.

Debbie stated the Town-Wide Clean Up is next week and the flyer, which lists items that will be picked up, is on the Town Website.


Ron moved to pay regular claims. Debbie seconded. Motion carried 2-0.
