

ORDINANCE NO. 2026- 05

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 9.06 OF THE  
FERDINAND MUNICIPAL CODE REGARDING TRAFFIC REGULATIONS**

**WHEREAS**, the Town Council has received advice from the public, its Police Chief, and its Property and Street Department Superintendent, since the adoption of Ordinance No. 2026-02, with respect to traffic volume, patterns and characteristics on certain of its residential streets and the continued need for ample room for local businesses to performing loading and unloading and utilize its loading dock as well as the need for pedestrians to have unfettered use of public ways; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town Council has determined that the current parking restrictions as to the South side of West Sixth Street between State Rd. 162 and Virginia Street should be modified and there should be no parking on the south side of that portion of W. Sixth St., except in the manner which follows.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE FERDINAND TOWN COUNCIL:**

1. Town Council partially repeals Ordinance 2026-02 and Section 9.06.010 of the Ferdinand Municipal Code is hereby amended to add as follows regarding no parking: Delete the current section (45) which was added by virtue of Ordinance 2026-02 and replace with:

(45) On the south side of West 6<sup>th</sup> Street between State Rd. 162 (Main Street) and Virginia Street.

2. The Street Department is directed to **immediately affix yellow curb painting reflecting this prohibition; remove the conflicting sign near Virginia Street; and replace it with signage stating authorized vehicle only here to corner, to allow the Ferdinand News business vehicle to continue to park at the end of that block of Sixth Street when it is not loading and unloading.**


3. The signage the local business needs to conspicuously designate its loading dock and indicating that only authorized vehicles are allowed and/or that violators will be towed shall be the expense of the business owner and by this ordinance the town council approves such signage without a corresponding permit application or fee.


4. This Ordinance shall be effective upon passage and publication as required by law.


