You're invited to help us show patriotism in our community!

What is it? The Ferdinand Kiwanis "Avenue of Flags" project allows flags to be flown at your home on patriotic holidays. The flags show our community's patriotism during these special holidays, adding to our beautiful town and neighborhoods. The funds raised by this project supports many of the Ferdinand Kiwanis service projects supporting our community youth.



How does it work? The Ferdinand Kiwanis Club will supply and place a 3'x5' American flag in front of your home or business on six holidays: **Memorial Day, Flag Day, Independence Day, Labor Day through 9/11, and Veteran's Day.** Kiwanis members will install a receptacle to place the flag in, will place the flag before the holiday, and collect the flag once the holiday is over, leaving NO WORK FOR YOU! The receptacle will be placed near the curb and as closely in line with your front door as possible.

How much does it cost? Subscriptions are \$40. This covers one flag for one year. Ferdinand Kiwanis will take full responsibility for repair or replacement of any flag that is worn, damaged, or stolen.
