President Dan Collignon called the Ferdinand Redevelopment Commission meeting to order at 5:00 p.m. on June 21, 2026, with all members present except Ron Weyer.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

The June meeting minutes were reviewed and unanimously approved after a motion by Ken and a second by Tammy.

Members received a draft BOT agreement prepared by Tom Pitman for review. It was noted that the bond agreement must be completed before the BOT agreement can be adopted. Members were asked to read the draft of the BOT before the next meeting.

Town Attorney, Sharon Bohnenkemper, reported that Morley Group contacted her to advise that they finished the surveying work to transfer out a 7-acre portion of a PIC parcel, the portion located just north of SR 264. The Auditor's office advised in May to make the correction to the parcel.

Prior to this meeting, Ken distributed the list of Comprehensive Plan Action items to Commission members. He invited the RDC to be involved with Plan commission at a special meeting to be held at Station 313 on August 17th at 7:00 p.m. All members were in favor of participating in that meeting.

There being no further business, Tammy motioned to adjourn. Ken seconded. The meeting adjourned at 5:20 p.m.
