

**ORDINANCE 2026- 17**

**ORDINANCE RESCINDING ORDINANCE 96-3 ON CONFINED AIR SPACE PROGRAM**

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Ferdinand passed and adopted an Ordinance, 1996-3, providing requirements for a confined air space program including log out/tag out procedures and other procedural matters; and

**WHEREAS**, the requirements of OSHA change over the years and have changed since 1996 when that ordinance was adopted, and

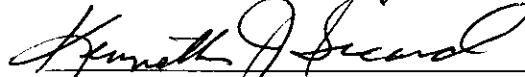
**WHEREAS**, the Town Council of the Town of Ferdinand finds that it is in the best interest of the Town of Ferdinand that Ordinance 96-3 be rescinded and that the procedural requirements would be best kept internally so as to facilitate changes and not be in the municipal code.

**NOW THEREFORE**, be it duly resolved by the Town Council of the Town of Ferdinand, Indiana:

That Ordinance 96-3 be, and it hereby is, rescinded. All of Chapter 3.20 should be removed/deleted from the Ferdinand Municipal Code.
